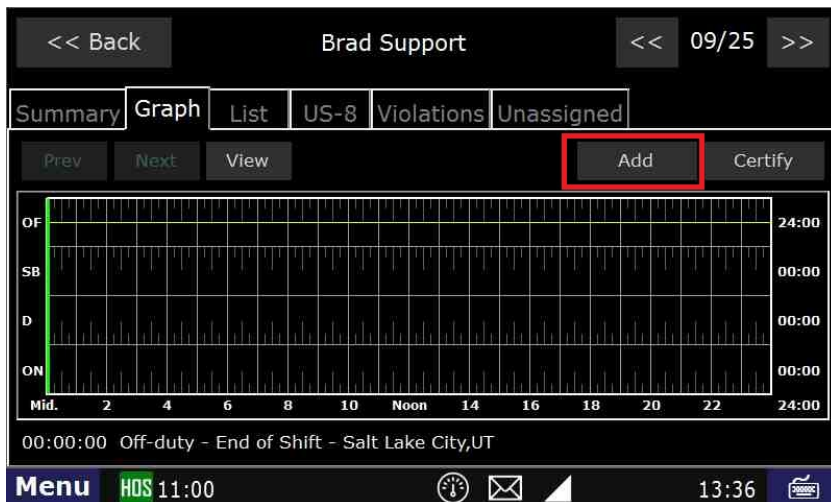


# How-to go On-Duty From the HOS Graph

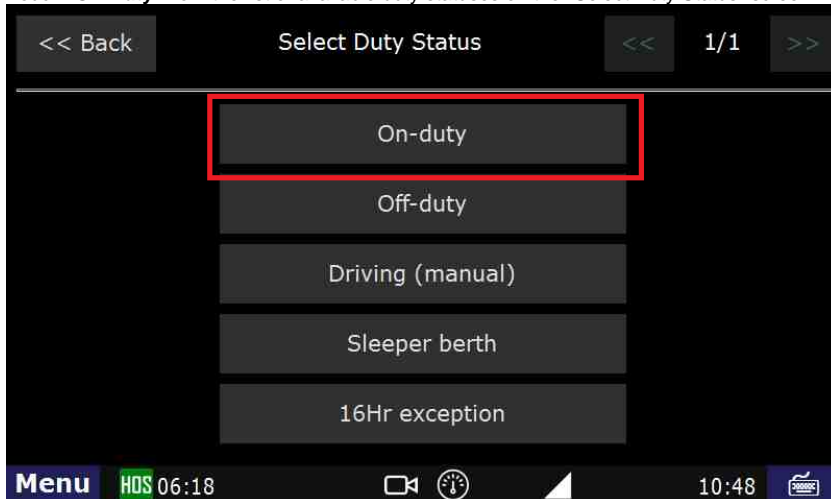
## How-to go On-Duty From the HOS Graph

### Step-by-step guide

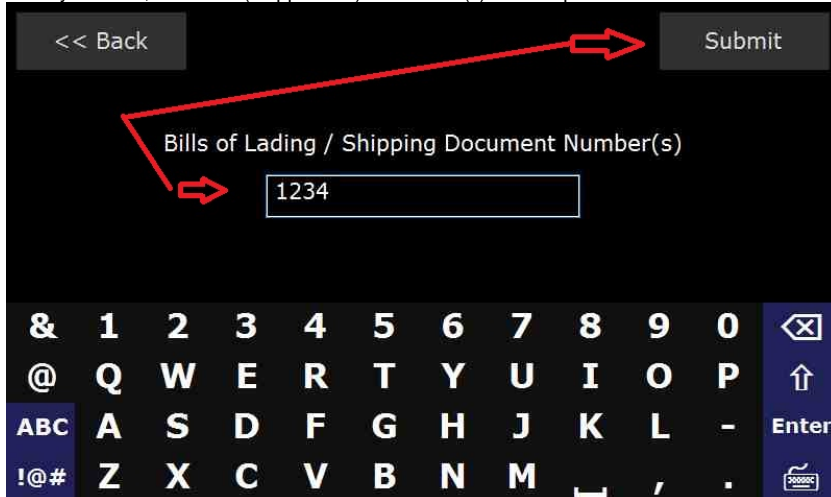
1. From the Graph tab in the HOS application, touch the **"Add"** button.
  - a. If prompted, enter your location into the location field.



2. Touch **"On-Duty"** from the list of available duty statuses on the "Select Duty Status" screen.



3. Enter your BOL, Co-driver (if applicable) and Trailer(s) into the provided fields and touch **"Submit."**

4. Answer "Is this the beginning of your shift?" with either "Yes" or "No" and follow the prompts.
