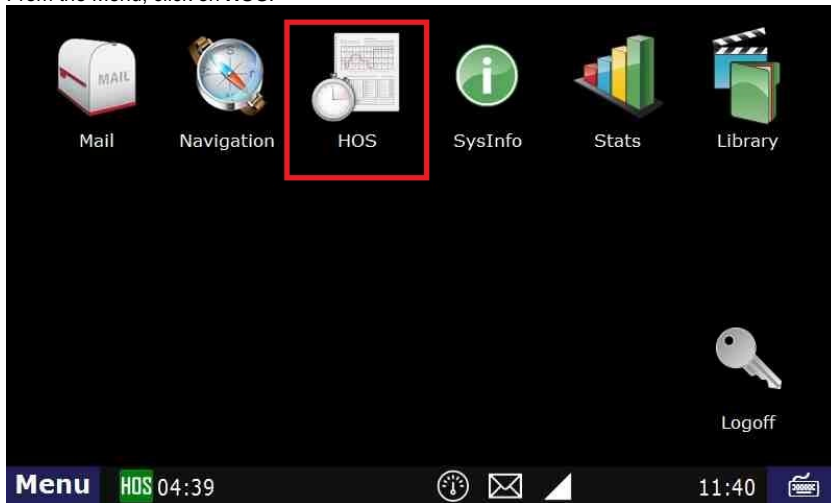
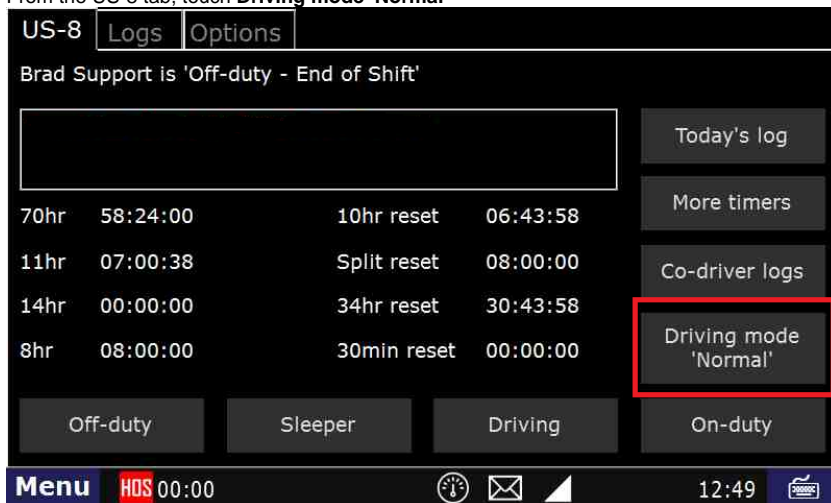


How-to put a truck into Personal Use or Yard Move

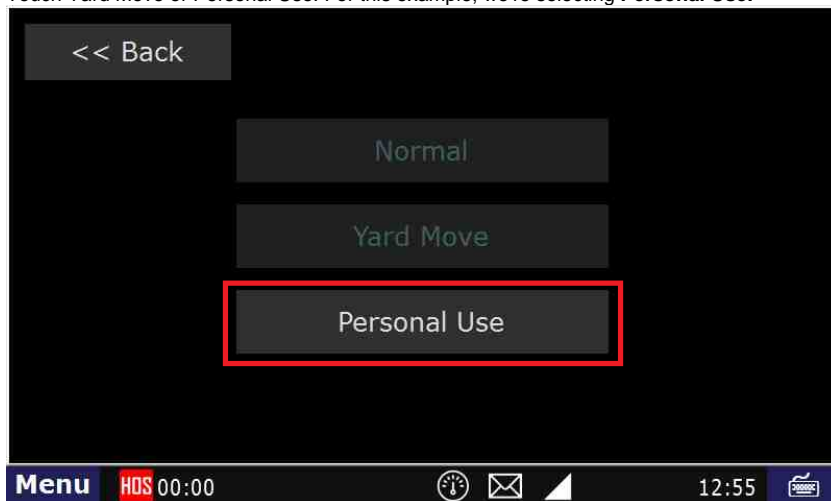
1. From the Menu, click on **HOS**.



2. From the US-8 tab, touch **Driving mode 'Normal'**



3. Touch Yard Move or Personal Use. For this example, we're selecting **Personal Use**.



How-to put a truck into Personal Use or Yard Move

4. A screen will come up explaining what is allowed and prohibited. Note: your company may have more restrictive rules than FMCSA, so make sure you verify that with your company Safety department. When you've read this, touch "Yes"

Allowed:

- Traveling between en-route lodging & another location
- Traveling between terminal & home, or home after working offsite
- Moving to the nearest safe location after loading or unloading
- Moving a CMV at the request of a safety official during off-duty

Prohibited:

- Positioning yourself closer to your next dispatch
- Time spent traveling to terminal after loading or unloading
- Time spent transporting a CMV to a facility for maintenance
