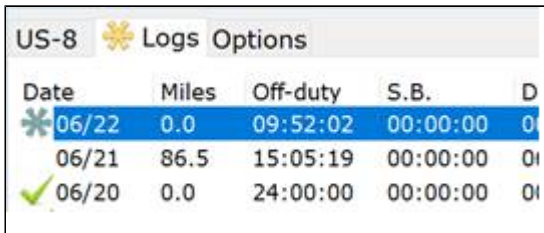

Step-by-step guide

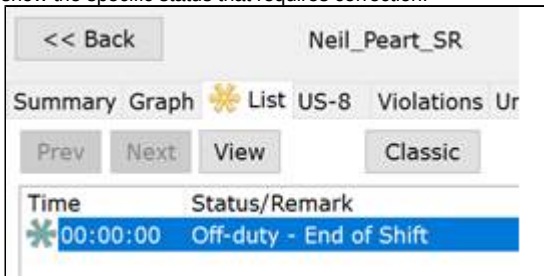
1. Select the date that requires a location update (indicated by a yellow star):

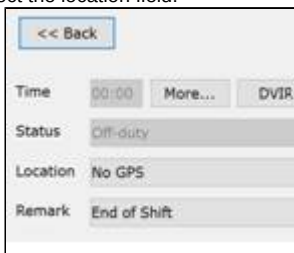

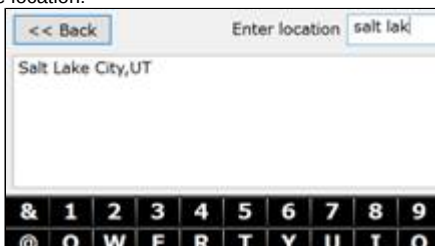
