

How can a driver combine their on-duty not driving status on an ELD, with Driving?

Question:

How can a driver combine their on-duty not driving status, such as working in a warehouse, on an ELD, prior to operating a commercial motor vehicle equipped with an ELD?

Answer:

All of the driver's hours of service must be accounted for when subject to the HOS rules. Prior to operating a commercial motor vehicle equipped with an ELD, the driver can manually add any on-duty not driving time accrued prior to.

1. When selecting an On-Duty status, there are several remarks to choose from. If none of these apply, you can select Other.
