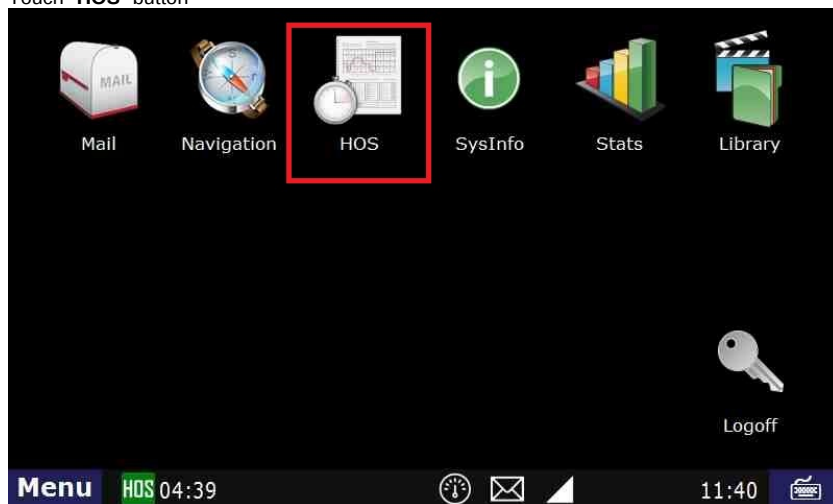

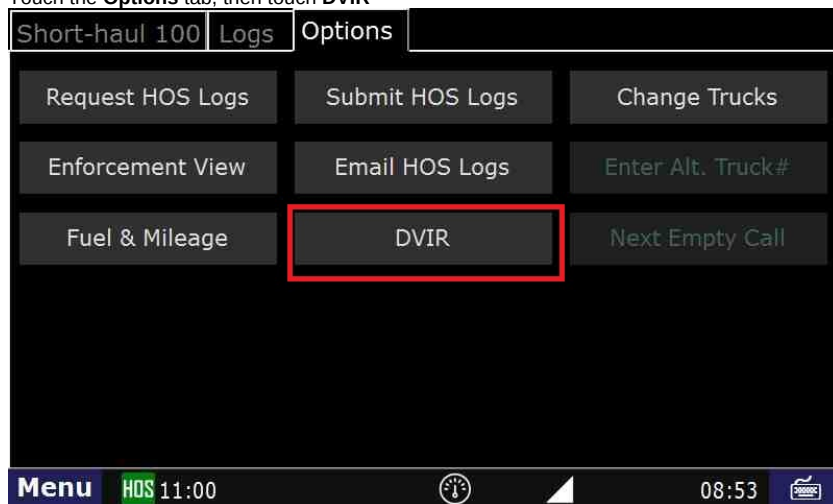
How-to Review and Certify your DVIR

Step-by-step guide

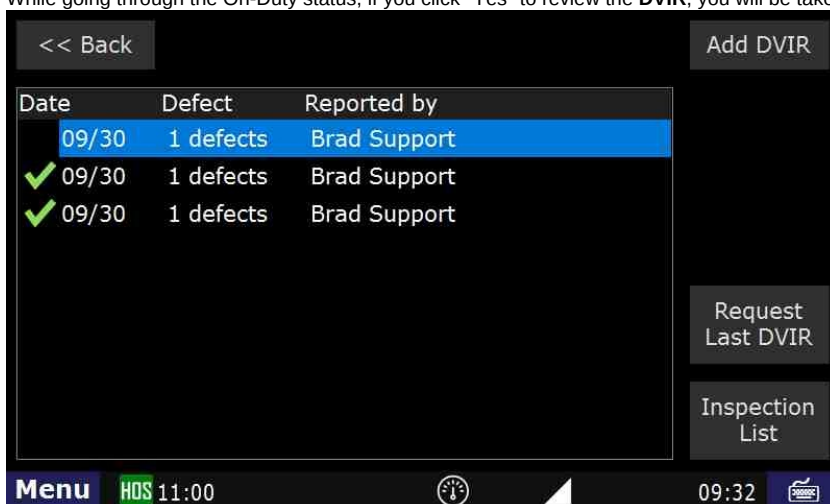
1. Touch "HOS" button



2. Touch the **Options** tab, then touch **DVIR**



3. Touch the "DVIR" you would like to review
 - a. While going through the On-Duty status, if you click "Yes" to review the DVIR, you will be taken to this screen.

4. Touch <Select repair status>
